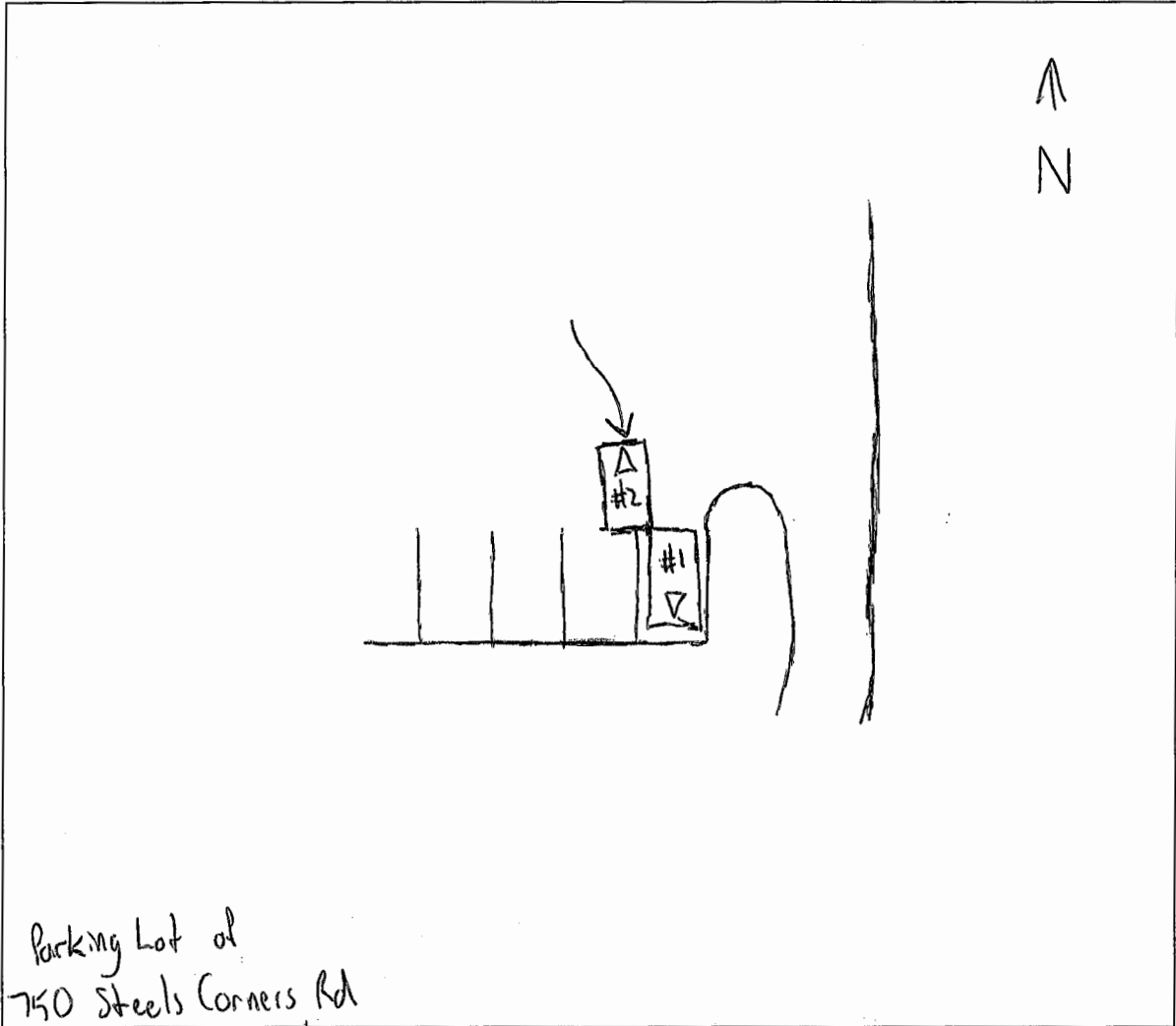

On 7/16/24 at 1400hrs, I was dispatched to 750 Steels Corners Rd in regards to a hit-skip. The suspect vehicle was a black Dodge Charger with Ohio license plate UNDEAD. This vehicle belonged to 30yo Rachel Deann Durst who had a listed address of 379 Hardman Dr in Cuyahoga Falls. The suspect vehicle fled eastbound on Steels Corners Rd.

Upon my arrival to that area, I did not see the suspect vehicle. I responded to 750 Steels Corners Rd and spoke with the victim, Shaylean Coble. Her vehicle was currently parked facing southbound in the far east spot in front of the gas station. Shaylean stated this is where her car was parked when the accident occurred. I saw there was damage on the right rear of her black Jeep Commander. The damage consisted of denting and paint gouges.

Shaylean stated she was inside her vehicle on the phone when she felt her car being struck. She said the vehicle that struck her had been attempting to back their vehicle into the spot to the west of hers. The suspect vehicle then pulled forward next to a pump and stopped there. Shaylean exited her vehicle and approached the driver of the suspect vehicle, who was still sitting in the vehicle. Shaylean advised the driver that she had just struck Shaylean's car. The white female driver, whom Shaylean described as wearing something covering her head and sunglasses, asked if the damage was bad and then asked if she could just pay for it. When Shaylean told her that she needed to call the police for an accident report, the female began yelling, unknown what was said, before quickly driving away. Shaylean said there was also a young child, maybe 4 years old, in the front passenger seat unbuckled.

Shaylean stated there were two witnesses. The first was Walter Benson, who supplied a business card. I was able to speak with Walter on the phone. He confirmed everything that Shaylean had told me. He observed the suspect vehicle at pump 9 facing north. He saw the vehicle begin to reverse towards the parking spot next to Shaylean's vehicle. He saw the suspect vehicle guiding towards Shaylean's vehicle and then strike it. The suspect vehicle pulled forward and he saw Shaylean speaking with the driver, and the driving quickly leaving with a child in the front seat.

The second witness was Stephanie Bolden. I was able to speak with Stephanie on the phone as well. Stephanie stated she did not see the accident but she did see Shaylean approach the suspect vehicle driver, whom she described as being a white female approximately in her 30's wearing a hat. Stephanie could hear the suspect ask about the damage and offer to pay for it. She saw the suspect vehicle then flee.

I looked up the vehicle using the Flock cameras and saw that the vehicle was southbound on Wyoga Lake Rd at the Peachtree Apts at 1354hrs and then eastbound on Steels Corners Rd at the Stow city limits at 1355hrs. After the accident, the vehicle was seen at the intersection of Home Ave and Tallmadge Ave and then Bailey Rd and Tallmadge Rd.

Later in the day I drove by Rachel's residence, 379 Hardman Dr, but did not see the vehicle there. I also drove by the residence the following day. The vehicle was not there but another vehicle belonging to Rachel was parked in front of the apartment so I attempted to make contact. I did not get an answer at the door. I drove by the apartment again on 7/18/24; the vehicle was not there. I called the phone number we have for Rachel, but was only able to leave a message.

On several other occasions, I drove by the apartment but never saw the vehicle there. On 7/30/24, I called several times and left a message. On 7/31/24, I called several more times and left a third message. I also went back to her apartment. I noticed that the other vehicle that is registered to her had moved. I also noticed that the apartment windows were open. I did not receive a response when I knocked on the door. An AMHA van drove past and stopped to ask if I needed assistance. I told them I was trying to speak with Rachel. They were familiar with her and stated she was not easy to get ahold of. They gave me the phone number for "Trina" Robinson, the apartment complex manager. I called that phone number but could only leave a message. I left a business card in Rachel's front door.

I had seen from previous calls that Chad Heide appeared to have a child with Rachel. I called Chad and was able to speak with him. He said he also cannot get in contact with her. He was able to confirm her phone number. He said he believed the Dodge Charger was at Rachel's mother's house at 1530 Vicgross Ave Akron, OH. I found that Rachel's mother's name is Wendy Derita. Chad later called me back and said that he drove past Wendy's residence and the vehicle was there.

Later in the day, I went to 1530 Vicgross Ave. The vehicle was still parked in the driveway. It had damage which coincided with the accident. I attempted to make contact but did not receive an answer at the door. I left a business card in the front door as well as one on the Dodge Charger. I had previously spoken with Prosecutor Konovsky and was advised not to tow it.

On 8/1/24, I received a voicemail from Rachel. I was able to call her back and speak with her on the phone. Rachel informed me she had just gotten my voicemail. She stated she did not know what accident I was talking about. I told her that I had read some reports of incidents she has recently been involved in and I know she's going through a lot right now but I needed her to be honest. Rachel admitted to driving the vehicle. She said she pulled up to gas pump on the wrong side of her car. She had to readjust to the other side of the pump. When she backed up, she thought she hit a curb. She then began to feel ill and needed to go to the hospital so she left. She stated she did not know she hit another car. I told her that three people informed me of the conversation she had with the driver of the other vehicle. She denied this stating that she did not speak with anybody.

I explained to Rachel that she would be getting a ticket and we would need to meet for her to receive this ticket. She began to ask how much the ticket would be and eluded to just paying the ticket. We agreed to meet on Saturday, 8/3/24, so the ticket could be served to her. As planned, the citation was issued to her at her residence on 8/3/24. She provided an insurance card from National General Insurance with the policy number 2023961015.

Nothing further to report at this time.
