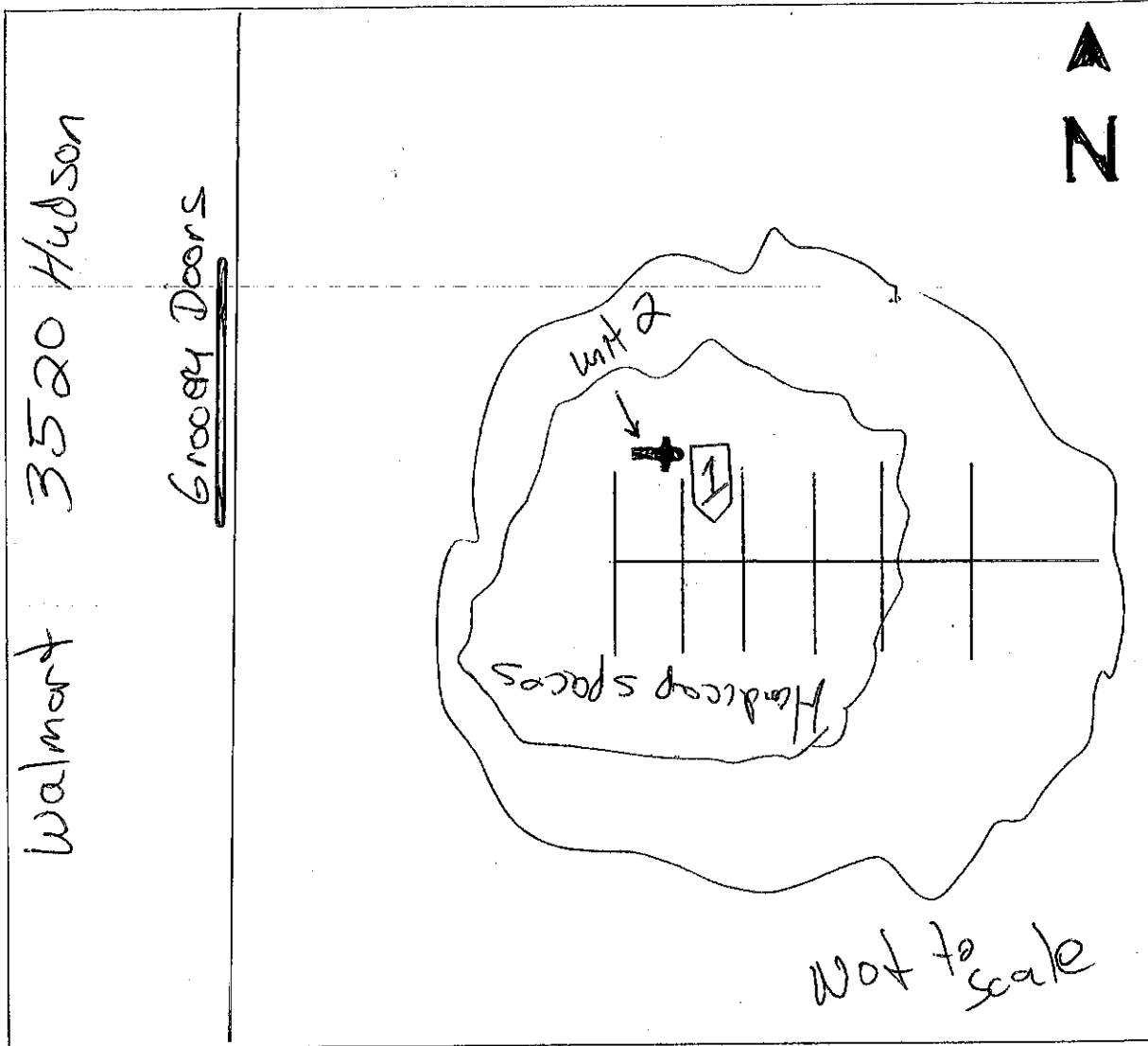

In regards to this incident, I had been dispatched to meet CFPD at the Huntington Bank branch, 2878 State Rd, Cuyahoga Falls, to meet with CFPD who had a party that wanted to report an accident at Walmart, 3520 Hudson Dr.

Upon my arrival at the Huntington bank lot, I met with CFPD Officer Cserhati who stated that a female, Leslie Turner, was reporting being involved in an incident at the Stow Walmart. Ofc. Cserhati reported that Turner had been checked out by their FD and was told by them to follow up later, per my BWC review on 03-25-20. This supplement is the result of Turner refuting my original narrative on the private property accident form that she refused treatment.

Ofc. Cserhati stated CFPD officers had gone to the residence of the other alleged involved party and that female would be enroute back here to Huntington Bank.

I spoke to Leslie Turner who had reported an elderly white female had been backing her car out of a handicap space as Turner was pushing a shopping cart from the grocery doors at Walmart. Turner advised that the female, later identified as Carrie Leslie, had backed her car into Turner's shopping cart which was then pushed into Turner. Turner stated she had tried to tell Leslie to be careful and there were allegedly words between the two of them.

She stated that Leslie then left the area. Turner stated she waited for her daughter to exit Walmart and then they followed Leslie until she turned into this Huntington Bank on State Rd where she took a picture of the plate. Turner stated that her daughter had gone into the bank to confront Leslie while I assume Turner called 911 from the parking lot.

I did speak to Turner and her daughter at the Huntington Bank. I got Turner's information and told Turner I would be in touch with her in the future.

I waited at the bank until Carrie Leslie arrived. We spoke in the foyer of the bank due it raining.

Carrie Leslie stated she had come to the bank to pay a bill when Turner's daughter came into the bank and put a camera in her face and took her picture saying "you hit my mom" and then left the bank. When Leslie left the bank, Turner told her she "called the police". Leslie stated she did not feel she did anything wrong and had left to go home.

I took everyone's information and proceeded to attempt contact with Walmart Loss Prevention in order to get a copy of the parking lot surveillance tape. Due to employee issues, it took me almost three weeks to get a copy.

When I reviewed the copy, I could see the incident in question. However, based on what I saw off the video, I did not see Turner's shopping cart move enough to indicate that it was struck by Leslie's car. I could see Turner pointing at Leslie's car as she walked around the car and continued EB in the parking lot.

I later completed the private property AR and turned it in to Records.
