Dog poop contains bacteria

It contains high level of fecal coliforms, like E. coli, as well as high levels of nutrients, like phosphorus.



Unnatural diets

Domestic dogs have a different diet than wild dogs, which causes higher pollutant levels.



Precipitation washes dog poop into our water

Many storm drains empty directly into our streams and lakes. Picking up poop prevents bacteria from dog poop from polluting our waters.
