

Annual Parade and Firecracker Run Will Cause Road Closings on Fourth of July

The City of Stow will be holding two significant community events on Friday, July Fourth: the Stow Firecracker Run and the Stow Fourth of July Parade. Both annual events will impact the regular flow of traffic on that morning.

The Stow Firecracker Run will begin at 7:30am at Holy Family Church, proceeding east on Kent Road to the Stow Community Shopping Center (Target Plaza), and then returning to the church. The Stow Fourth of July Parade will start at 10:00 am from the Stow Community Shopping Center (Target Plaza), heading west on Kent Road, ending at Holy Family Church. As a result of these events, the following road closures will be necessary:

Kent Road (SR 59)

Kent Road will be closed from Marsh Road to McCormick Road in the Village of Silver Lake at the following estimated times:

- 7:15am to 8:30am
- 9:30am to 12:30pm

Darrow Road (SR 91)

Darrow Road will be closed from Graham Road to Pinehurst Road in the City of Munroe Falls at the following estimated times:

- 7:15am to 8:30am
- 9:30am to 12:30pm

Emergency vehicles will be the only through traffic allowed during the restricted periods. Some businesses in the area will remain open, and employees needing to access their workplaces should use Fishcreek Road to reach Kent Road (SR59).

Furthermore, there will be NO ON-STREET PARKING permitted on Englewood Dr. from RT 59 to Oak Hill Rd, and Charring Cross Drive from RT 59 to Graham Rd, 6 AM until 1 PM on July 4, 2025.
