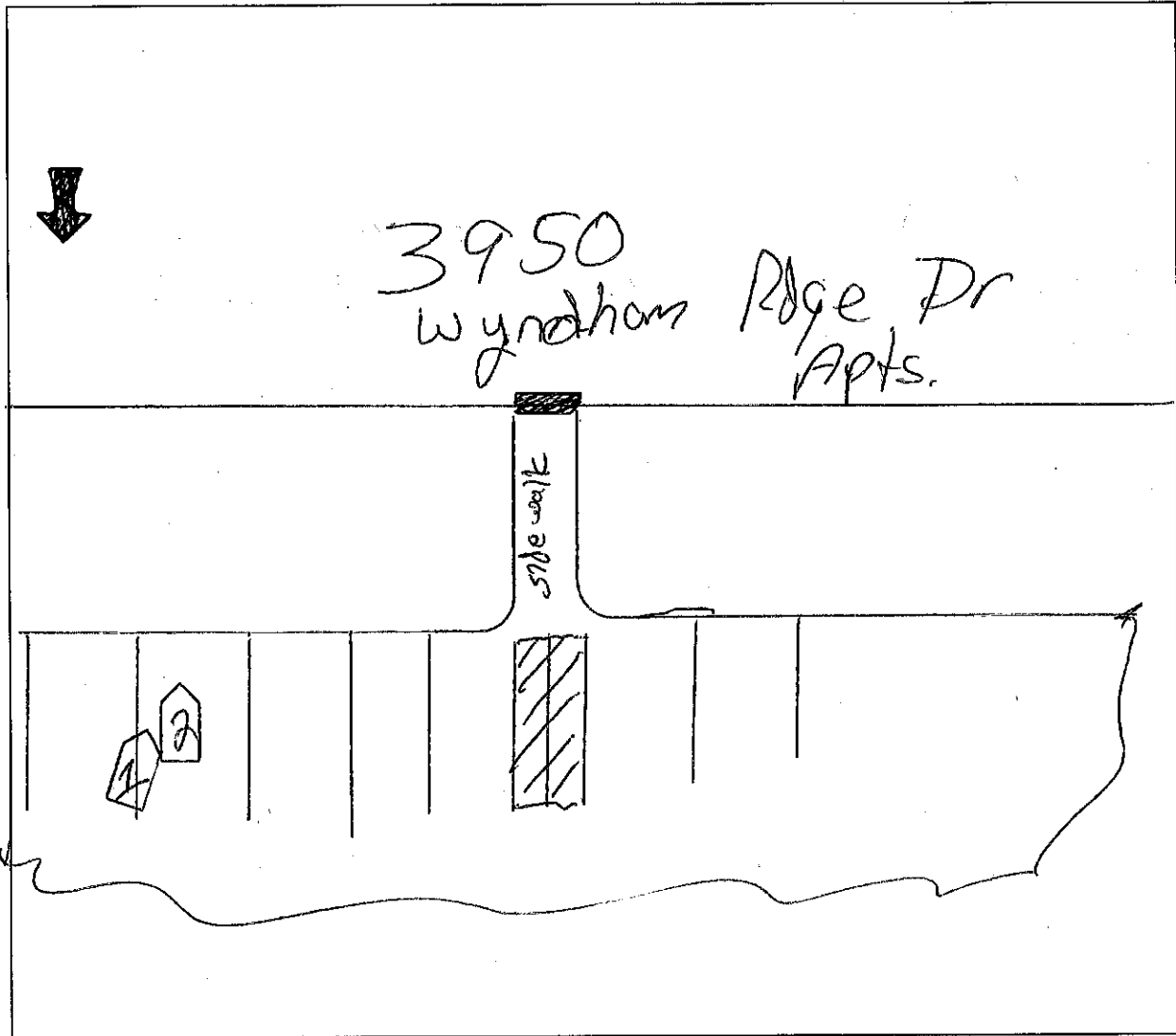

On the above date and time, Shiva P. Velanki, 3950 Wyndham Ridge Dr, #206, Stow, Oh 44224, called to report his friend's car had been damaged while it was parked outside the apartment building.

Velanki stated he had been in possession of a red 2014 Toyota Corolla, OH registration GZQ3976, belonging to Dimple Singh, for the last month or two.

Velanki stated he had been on vacation in India for about the last month and had left the car parked in a space in front of the apartment building. He advised Dimple Singh and her husband are also in India currently and have been for quite awhile.

Velanki advised when he came back to his apartment on 07/06/2021 he had found the Toyota Corolla had been struck in the rear driver's quarter panel/bumper area. There was moderate scratches left. He advised that later in the day, he observed a maroon Hyundai Sante Fe, OH registration EDK4524, in one of the nearby parking spaces with damage consistent to the Toyota Corolla as well as having red paint transfer. Velanki stated after knocking on some doors in the apartment building he found someone who drives the Hyundai to live in 3950 Wyndham Ridge, #207. Velanki also took several pictures of the Hyundai Sante Fe as well at that time.

I could not find the Hyundai Sante Fe or anyone at #207 at that time, but returned later in the day to find the Sante Fe.

I eventually spoke to Cory A. Buckley, DOB 01/13/1988, at that address. Cory was asked what happened with the Sante Fe striking the red Toyota Corolla. He claimed he has not driven the Sante Fe but claimed his girlfriend, Teran Marie Smith, DOB 12/01/1990, usually drives it. I asked if she was around and Buckley advised that she was at work.

I had already learned from management at Wyndham Ridge Apts. that Teran Smith had recently moved out of the complex as well.

Buckley was slightly difficult in dealing with. He was reluctant to provide many details about the Sante Fe. I eventually told him that I was going to tow the Sante Fe due to it being a hit skip vehicle if I could not figure things out. I also informed him there would be no citations due to this being a private property crash.

I informed Buckley of the matching damage to both cars and that I was going to list the Hyundai Sante Fe as the at fault vehicle. He would not provide any information as to who may have been driving the Sante Fe either. Buckley did provide an American Family insurance policy number of 4103521262 for himself.

After leaving the scene, I looked Buckley and Smith up in LEADS and found them both to be DUS. I placed their information with this report.

I asked our Records Dept. if I could add a narrative to this Hit Skip report and was told I could send it to them via email and they would take care of it.
