


PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS,** The City of Stow is honored to recognize and acknowledge Kenmore Construction for completing the SUM-8-7.81 Freeway Reconstruction Project on time with minimal disruption to the traveling public and the citizens of Stow; and
- WHEREAS,** Kenmore Construction was awarded the SUM-8-7.81 Reconstruction Project from Graham Road to North of S.R. 303 in the second half of 2018 with a low bid of \$58,617,907.64; and
- WHEREAS,** Kenmore Construction immediately went to work to install traffic signals on the Seasons Road off ramps and reinforce the berms along this 5.7 miles stretch of freeway to improve maintenance of traffic and safety before construction beginning in 2019; and
- WHEREAS,** Kenmore Construction worked diligently and efficiently during the COVID-19 outbreaks of 2020 and 2021 meeting all deadlines, completing and opening ramps and lanes throughout the pandemic, without delays; and
- WHEREAS,** Kenmore Construction trained safety forces on use of the gates to access contra-flow lanes, provided equipment and personnel to assist in any emergency, and held weekly meetings on site with City of Stow safety forces to ensure immediate access to any project location; and
- WHEREAS,** Kenmore Construction provided the City of Stow Police Department safe pull off locations for running radar both during the project and upon completion of the project.
