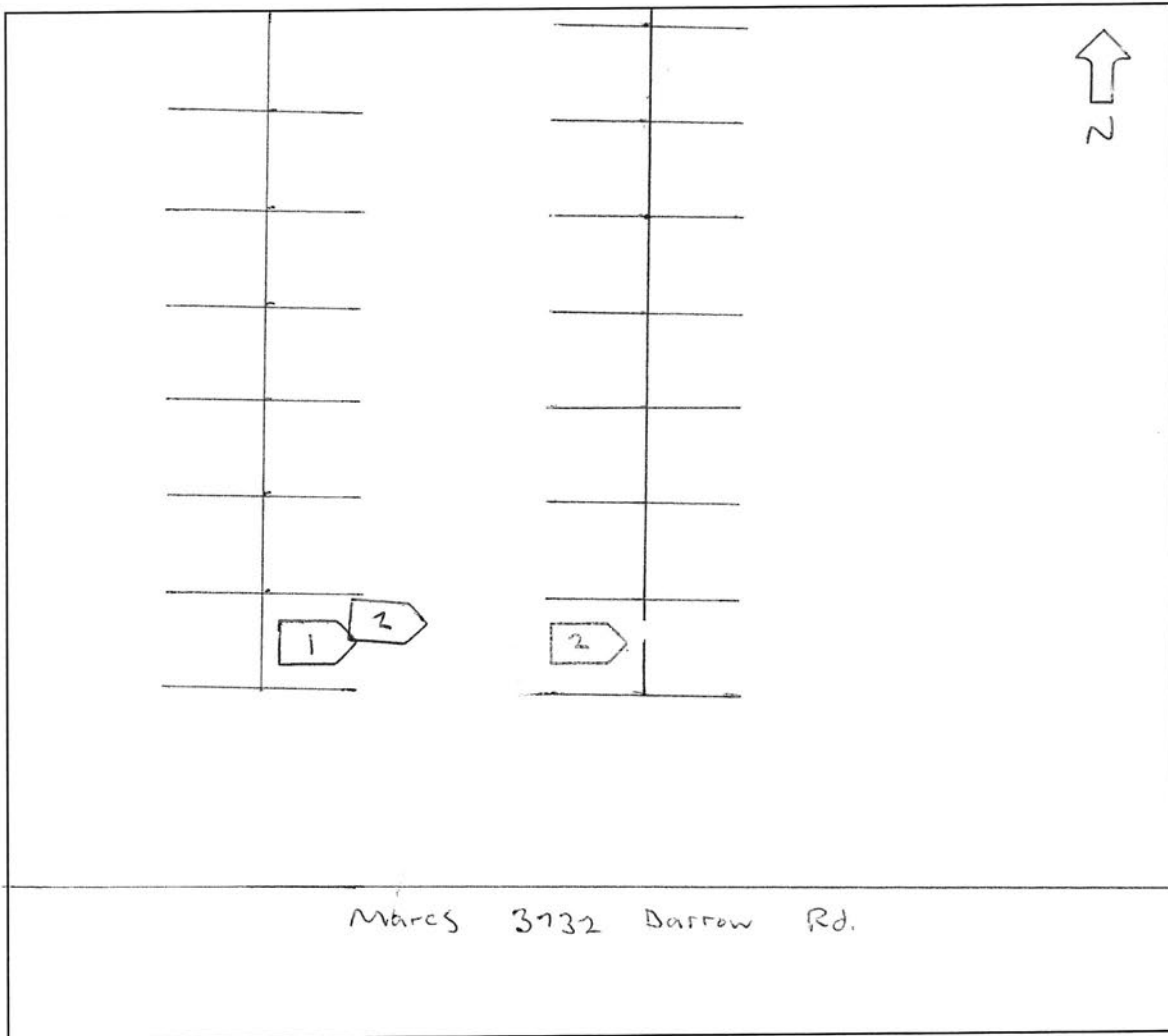

Catherine witnessed the crash when she was walking in the parking lot. She wrote down the plate with her name and phone number. She gave it to an employee who determined it was a fellow employees car that was hit. That employee (Nicholas Hartman [REDACTED] [REDACTED]) came into the police department later to request a report. He showed me his vehicle which had a crack in the left front bumper.

The following day I ran the plate and it returned to a male in Hudson on a beige 2015 Jeep Grand Cherokee. The plate expired 8-2022. I ran a car fax on the vehicle and saw it was sold 9-2022. I called the owner and he said he traded the Jeep into a Mercedes dealership in Bedford, OH. The plate was left on the vehicle. Either someone stole his plate or the witness got the plate wrong.

I called Catherine and she was sure the vehicle was not a Jeep. I went to Marcos and they had no video surveillance of their parking lot.
