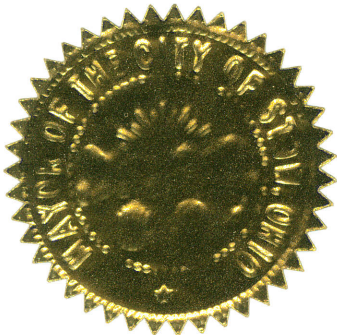
Whereas, June 4th, 2023, Jayla competed in the 800 meter race at the Ohio High School Athletic Association State tournament in Columbus, Ohio; and,
