Stow Income Tax Ordinance Chapter 194 requires any individual 18 years or older whose permanent residence is in the City of Stow for any portion of the tax year to file a tax return with the City of Stow on April 15th (or the IRS Due Date) of each applicable year. This is a requirement even if no tax is due. Exemptions apply if **ALL** income is non-taxable. The City of Stow is **NOT** a RITA municipality. If you received this form, the city received notification of a change in ownership of this property and automatically sent this with additional new owner information.

Please complete this form and return it to the Stow Income Tax office within 10 days. **Fillable PDFs are available on our website.** If you moved from one Stow address to another, complete this form so we can update your account with your new residence. Please **DO NOT EMAIL** the Income Tax office any documents containing unprotected social security numbers or personal information. Once registered with the Income Tax office, the E-File website is available to use for filing and payment options.
